

THE ST. PAUL'S ACCOUNTABILITY PACT

A Higher Standard for Leadership

A public compact offered on equal terms to all three candidates contesting St. Paul — Franz DeFreitas, Chet Greene, and Alan Weston — ahead of the general election on April 30, 2026.

PREAMBLE

The people of St. Paul deserve more than promises. They deserve clarity, access, and results they can see and measure.

This Accountability Pact sets a clear, written standard for leadership — outlining what will be done, by when, and how progress will be reported.

This is not about party. This is not about personalities. This is about accountability to the people of St. Paul.

This pact is offered on equal terms to every candidate contesting the constituency. Any candidate who signs commits, in writing, to serving with transparency, accessibility, and measurable action. Alan Weston signs only as the pact's independent public monitor, and is not bound by the commitments themselves.

This pact belongs to the people — and the people will hold it to account.

CORE COMMITMENTS

If elected Member of Parliament for St. Paul on April 30, 2026, any candidate who signs this pact agrees to deliver on each of the following.

1. Access to Your Representative

- A public town hall within 60 days of taking office
- Public constituency meetings at least every 3 months
- Clear and accessible contact published within 14 days of being sworn in: phone, email, and a physical point of contact
- All meetings advertised at least 14 days in advance

2. Real Accountability

- Written progress reports every 6 months — published online and in print at a designated public location
- Public tracking of every commitment in this pact
- Clear status updates: completed, in progress, delayed, or unmet

3. Infrastructure That Matters

- Priority focus on roads, water, electricity, and drainage across the villages of St. Paul
- These issues raised in Parliament within the first 12 months
- Written summaries of responses from the responsible ministries published publicly

4. Opportunities for Our People

- A working session within 90 days with youth, local business owners, and community stakeholders
- Focus on jobs, training, sports, and economic growth
- Real priorities set with input from the people, with outcomes published

5. Transparency in Public Bodies

- Public advocacy for the timely publication of audited accounts, annual reports, and governance records for public bodies operating within or materially affecting St. Paul — including but not limited to the National Parks Authority
- A formal call in Parliament, at the first ordinary sitting, for the publication of the National Parks Authority's audited financials, a review of its governing Act, and clarification of the scope and limits of its powers
- Continued public reporting on any failure by these bodies to comply

6. Modern Communication & Responsiveness

- A public information channel launched within 120 days — website, app, or official messaging platform
- Easy access to updates, meeting dates, reports, and ways to submit concerns
- A response standard of 10 working days for all constituent matters

OVERSIGHT & ACCOUNTABILITY

This pact is not self-monitored, and it is not controlled by any one individual.

Alan Weston serves as its independent public monitor — not bound by the commitments himself, but committing to publicly assess and report on compliance throughout the parliamentary term, in respect of whichever signing candidate is elected.

A public review will be issued every six months, indicating whether each commitment has been completed, is underway, is delayed, or remains unmet. Any unmet commitment must be publicly explained, in writing, within a reasonable timeframe.

This pact is a public accountability agreement, not a legal contract. Its force comes from publicity, the public record, and political accountability to the people of St. Paul. Final accountability rests with the people.

PUBLIC ACCOUNTABILITY STANDARD

- This pact will be publicly accessible at all times
- Progress updates will be shared openly and regularly
- Any unmet commitment must be publicly explained within a reasonable timeframe
- This pact does not constitute party affiliation, merger, or political absorption
